

CHILDREN FIRST FAMILY LITERACY

Children First Family Literacy (CFFL) programming is a two-generation approach to tackling the issues of poverty and low literacy within families, and is a collaborative program between Literacy Green Bay, Northeast Wisconsin Technical College and Green Bay Area Public Schools. By educating parents and their children simultaneously, CFFL works to break this intergenerational cycle. Parents attend GED-prep classes as well as Parent Education sessions while their children attend nurturing early learning classes where they acquire preschool-readiness skills necessary to be successful in school. Parents and their children also come together to participate in Parent & Child Together time to help strengthen family bonds and teach parents how to further support their children's learning at home. With COVID-19 forcing all programming to switch from in-person to virtual in March of 2020, it was a very challenging, yet quite successful year overall! 20 families were served this fiscal year.

- 12 adult CFFL students took a total of...
- 23 GED subject tests.
- 1 adult earned their GED in the 2019-20 program year.
- 100% of parents and their toddlers were offered a variety of online early learning activities through
 Google Classroom to participate in together while attending programming virtually. Approximately 50% of
 families accessed the site throughout the program year.
- 100% of preschool-aged children were on track to develop the academic and social skills necessary to enter kindergarten successfully and on track with their peers.

COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS 1

Literacy Green Bay began offering College & Career Readiness Level 1 classes in August of 2018 as a result of a newly-formed collaboration with NWTC. This course is designed for lower-level readers who wish to bring their reading proficiency up to a level that will allow them to successfully transition into more rigorous GED coursework at NWTC. Specific reading strategies are taught using both established curriculum as well as the software program IXL.com. Once mastered, these strategies give students the confidence they need to dive into more extensive coursework and provide the foundation necessary to further explore post-secondary education beyond their GED. This class is currently offered for three hours, twice per week, on Monday mornings or Wednesday evenings. Despite a year fraught with many challenges for both teachers and learners who needed

to adapt to virtual learning, we were still highly successful in transitioning 8 learners to NWTC to continue their path toward GED attainment.

- 31 students enrolled in CCR1 in 2019-20 program year
- 8 students completed CCR1 and advanced to CCR2 at NWTC
- Of the 8 students who transitioned to NWTC, 1 learner went on to receive her HSED (High School Equivalency Diploma) this program year.

Literacy Green Bay offers four levels of English Language Learning Classes, from a Pre-literacy Level, designed for learners whose native languages are very distant from English, up to Level 2, for learners who can engage in conversational English and read and write basic paragraphs. Upon completion of Level 2, students can continue their English studies with our partner NWTC, and eventually enroll in career-oriented classes. To accommodate our learners' varied schedules, we offer classes both mornings and evenings, for 43 weeks per year. In 2020-2021, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, classes were completely virtual, as they were at the end of 2019-2020. This was a completely new way of learning for almost all of our students, many of whom did not have the technology to participate. Literacy Green Bay staff worked with students in whatever way necessary to get them connected and continue their learning, installing apps on their phones, lending them WiFi hotspots (thanks to generous grants from Greater Green Bay Community Foundation and Green Bay Packers Give Back), lending Chromebooks, and serving as "tech support" for whatever issues arose. Although overall student participation in this all-virtual year was lower than in years past with in-person learning, we added something new: the ability to provide instruction remotely. When we returned to in-person learning in August, 2021, we kept the Zoom feeds running and opened our in-person classes to remote learners, thereby providing more ways to access our classes than in any year past.

Literacy Green Bay offers tutoring services in a variety of subjects, including reading, writing, math, and/or English language skills to adults. Adult learners are matched with a personal tutor after taking reading and placement tests, and having an interview with a volunteer evaluator. In 2020-21, many tutoring pairs were "on hold" during the pandemic, waiting for vaccines and safety conditions to improve. Still, many learners continued to work with their tutors:

- 80 active tutoring pairs
- 45 learners advanced a grade level and/or met a personal goal while working with a tutor
- 26 new tutors were trained
- 21 tutors have tutored 10+ years
- 8 tutors have tutored 20+ years








Her work with the Literacy Council earned her several awards. 





Created in 1991, this fund is managed by the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation. Endowment funds are raised and maintained to provide long-term financial stability for Literacy Green Bay, but contributions to our endowment fund also enable Literacy Green Bay to fund current program needs. The Board of Directors reviews the budget annually and determines an appropriate withdrawal amount from the fund, up to 5% of the balance. This withdrawal is limited to 5%, which represents earnings and interest, so that the fund balance is still maintained and grows in order to support long-term financial needs. When donors designate contributions to the endowment, they are helping ensure continuity of programming for future generations.
